- ~ Single-family home
- ~ Located within the City of Rockford*
- ~ The owner must live in the home
- ~ Income guidelines apply ~ See below

The following documents will be needed when you interview for the program:

Income Information: Last two months check stubs ~ Social Security Award Letter ~ Court Ordered Child support statement ~ Proof of any other income

Tax Information: Most recent Federal & State tax returns ~ W-2 Statements

Other Information: Six most recent checking account statements ~ Most recent statement on all savings accounts, including Certificate of Deposits, IRA's, 401(k) and stocks ~ Proof of assets owned, such as statements showing the cash value of a life insurance policy, assessment of any property owned ~ Proof of ownership, such as deed, contract for purchase or agreement for deed ~ Illinois ID or Driver's License ~ Social Security Card
