

Are you over 60 and/or a person with disabilities? Does your home need to be modified due to a disability?

Northwestern Illinois Area Agency on Aging (NIAAA), Regional Access Mobilization Project (RAMP), and the City of Rockford may be able to help.

NIAAA and RAMP provide many services to elderly and/or persons with disabilities. Through these agencies, assistance may be available for you to make modifications to your home & ensure it meets the City of Rockford local code.

The maximum assistance is \$40,000. The assistance is not required to be repaid as long as you remain in your home for at least five (5) years after the work has been completed.

To be eligible you must:

- Own & live in your home (no rentals)
- You must have a need for a modification in your home due to your disability
- Be at least 60 years of age or physically disabled
- Live in the City of Rockford
- Household income must be at or below income limits, as shown in the chart below (income limits subject to change).
