ORDINANCE NO. 2016-3-O

WHEREAS, The City of Rockford is the owner of and possessed of the real estate hereinafter particularly described; and

WHEREAS, the said real estate is no longer necessary, appropriate or required for the use of, nor profitable to, the City of Rockford; and

WHEREAS, retention of the property is not for the best interest of said City of Rockford.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKFORD, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: The City Council offer for sale of City owned property a **Vacant Lot at 307 North Central Avenue, PIN# 11-22-104-005** at a minimum bid of **\$13,000.00** which includes advertising. The city reserves the right to reject all bids. The subject property is legally described as follows:

Lot Eight (8) in Block Nine (9) as designated upon the Plat of Dickerman & Robertson's West Addition to the City of Rockford, the Plat of which addition is recorded in Book 6 of Plats on Page 7 in the Recorder's Office of Winnebago County, Illinois, situated in the County of Winnebago and State of Illinois.

Section 2: The Notice of said sale and the fact that said City of Rockford will receive bids for the purchase of said real estate shall be advertised in the Rock River Times, a weekly newspaper published in said City of Rockford, for three (3) consecutive weeks, the first publication to be not less than thirty (30) days before the day provided in said Notice for the opening bids for the real estate.

Section 3: The said Notice shall set forth the fact that said bids will be received until 11:00 A.M., local Rockford time on **February 22, 2016** at the office of the City of Rockford Purchasing Manager and shall be accompanied by a bank cashier's or certified check payable to the City of Rockford for at least ten (10) percent of the amount of the bid, the balance to be paid in cash by the successful bidder within not more than fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of the City Council's acceptance of his bid. The City of Rockford reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.

Section 4: The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

Section 5: All orders, resolutions, or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law.

Section 6: A full, true, and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days after passage in pamphlet form by and under authority of the Corporate Authorities.
