ARREST RELEASE

ROCKFORD, ILL. – On October 1, 2016, members of the Rockford Specialized Community Oriented Police Enforcement team went to the area of 1200 12th Avenue to investigate a report of shots fired. Upon arrival, they observed several subjects standing in a driveway in the 1200 block of 12th Avenue. As officers approached the group, they observed a subject, later identified as 18-year-old Rockford resident Daniel Herrera, walk away from the group and discard a handgun. Officers subsequently arrested Herrera and recovered the firearm. Spent shell casings were also located in the driveway. Herrera was charged with the following offenses:

**Reckless Discharge of a Firearm
Unlawful Use of a Weapon
No FOID card**
