ARREST RELEASE

ROCKFORD, ILL. – On September 29, 2016 the Rockford Police Department asked the community for their assistance in identifying a white male who was the suspect in several burglaries that occurred at area retirement homes between September 15, 2016 and September 27, 2016.

Rockford Police Detectives developed 45 year old Rockford resident Jerry White as a suspect in these crimes. The investigative details was reviewed with the Winnebago County State’s Attorney’s Office and a warrant for burglary was issued for White with a bond of \$100,000.00.

On October 5, 2016 Rockford Police Officers located and arrested White on the warrant.

White is currently on Mandatory Supervised Release by the Illinois Department of Corrections for a prior burglary conviction.

White was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. A photo of White is attached.

No further information is available for release at this time.
