**ARREST RELEASE**

**ROCKFORD, Ill.** – On July 9, 2016, members of the Rockford Police Department were on patrol in the 900 block of Woodlawn Avenue when they observed a stolen Lexus occupied by two subjects. The officers made contact with the driver who was identified as 20-year-old Rockford resident, Tevin J. Gray. Officers learned that Gray’s license was suspended and he was wanted on a Winnebago County Failure to Appear warrant.

Officers then made contact with the passenger who was identified as 18-year-old Rockford resident, Corey O. Smith. Smith was found to be in possession of a quantity of marijuana and an undisclosed amount of cash. Both subjects were charged with the following offenses:

**Tevin J. Gray, B/M, Age 20**  
**Charges: Unlawful Possession of a Stolen Automobile**  
**Driving while License suspended**  
**Winnebago County Failure to Appear Warrant**

**Corey O. Smith, B/M, Age 18**  
**Charges: Violation of the Cannabis Control Act-Possession with Intent to Deliver**  
**Criminal Trespass to Vehicle**

Both Gray and Smith were lodged in jail.

This is an active investigation and no further information is available for release at this time. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.
