MESSAGE

On August 12th, 2011 at approximately 9:40 AM, patrol officers from the Rockford Police Department responded to the Check and Go Cash Store located at 160 N. Mulford Road in reference to an Armed Robbery investigation. When they arrived, officers learned 2 black male suspects, one armed with a handgun, entered the store and demanded money from the clerk. The suspects fled from the store with an undisclosed amount of currency. The clerk was not injured during the incident.

Detectives from the Rockford Police Department conducted follow up on the incident. On September 2nd, 2011 the facts of the investigation were reviewed with the Winnebago County States Attorney's Office who authorized the charge of Aggravated Robbery and arrest warrants were issued for the following suspects:

Karl Fort Jr, 18, Rockford
Will A. Evans, 18, Rockford

Fort and Evans are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
