Community Action to Help with Property Clean-up

ROCKFORD, ILL. – The Community Action Agency of Winnebago and Boone Counties will once again offer a program this summer to assist eligible homeowners in need of one-time limited lawn maintenance and property clean-up. The SWEEP program for residents of Boone and Winnebago Counties is now taking applications from eligible home owners.

Homeowner applicants must be residents of Winnebago or Boone County, meet low-income guidelines, be 65 years or older, or show proof of a disability. Please note that available slots for homeowners are limited.

Eligible homeowners may pick up applications at the following sites: For Winnebago County residents, the Community Services Division of the City of Rockford Human Services Department, 555 N.
