Incident: **Burglary suspect arrested**

MESSAGE

On Sunday August 21st, 2011 shortly before 6:00 AM, Rockford Police Officers responded to the Rockford County Club Pro Shop located in the 2500 block of Oxford Street in reference to a Burglary. After arriving at the scene, officers conducted an investigation of the Burglary that occurred at the business.

Rockford Police Detectives conducted follow-up investigation on the Burglary. On September 26th, 2011, the facts of the investigation were reviewed with the Winnebago County States Attorney's Office who authorized the charge of Burglary on James M. Mabrey, 49 years of age. An arrest warrant was issued for Mabrey's arrest.

On September 27th, 2011, Mabrey was taken into custody without incident. During additional follow up by detectives, it was learned that Mabrey was involved in other Burglary's at Sinnissippi Park, RJ Bower and the Rockford County Club Pro Shop.

Mabrey is currently on parole for Burglary in Winnebago County. The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole Division issued a parole violation warrant for Mabrey

Mabrey is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
