Incident: **Aggravated Battery to a Municipal Employee**

MESSAGE

On Sunday, 12/22/13 at approximately 11:30 am Rockford Police were summoned by Rockford Public Works personnel to the 1400 block of Jackson Street for a disorderly subject.

Two Rockford Public Works employees were enforcing the emergency snow parking ordinance when they observed a man snow blowing snow from a driveway into the street. The Public Works employees stopped and informed the man that it was a violation of City Ordinance to deposit snow into the street. The man become irate and used profanity directed at the female employee. The man then directed his snow blower's chute towards the public works truck and discharged snow at the Public Works truck. The snow entered the open passenger door window and hit the male Public Works employee in the head and chest.

Upon Police Officers arrival Public Works employees pointed out the offender, who then fled into his home. After several minutes of talking the male exited his residence and was taken into custody without further incident.

Aggravated Battery, Disorderly Conduct, Resisting/Obstructing, Obstructing Identification, Ordinance Violation (16-136 depositing snow on a roadway)

The charges against Donovan are accusations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
