MESSAGE

On Sunday, September 1st, 2013 shortly after 2:00 AM, members of the Rockford Police Department responded to the Road Ranger located at 3302 11th Street in reference to an Aggravated Robbery. Officers learned the suspect entered the business and demanded money from the clerk. The suspect left the business with an undisclosed amount of cash.

Rockford Police Detectives conducted follow up investigation into the incident. The facts of the investigation were reviewed by the Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office. The following charges were authorized:

Christopher J. Robinson, 29 years of age, Rockford, Illinois
Aggravated Robbery
Robbery

Rockford Police Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Robinson.

The charges against Robinson are merely accusations. He is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
