ARREST RELEASE

On Monday March 14, at 1:53 a.m. Rockford Police officers responded to Broadway Food and Liquor, 2710 Broadway, in reference to a strong arm robbery. The suspect was described as a white male wearing a black t-shirt and blue jeans. He got into the passenger seat of a black Chevy Tahoe and fled the area. Assisting officers located a black Chevy Tahoe in the area at around 2:14 a.m. and stopped the Tahoe near the intersection of 20th St and 11th Ave.

The front seat passenger matched the description of the suspect from the strong arm robbery at the Broadway Food and Liquor; he was identified as Jeramie Dahlauser. The driver was identified as Sammy Eslora.

The victim, a 25-year-old Rockford resident, advised he was walking to the front door of the business when the suspect, who was already parked in the lot, walked up and punched him. The victim fell to the ground and the suspect punched him several more times before taking the victim's wallet.

Dahlauser and Eslora were transported to the PSB to be questioned and detectives were called in after follow-up investigation, the following arrests were made:

Jeramie Dahlauser, 32-year-old Rockford resident, arrested for: Robbery, Criminal Damage to Property

Sammy Eslora, 38-year-old Rockford resident, arrested for: Aggravated DUI and other traffic charges



Dahlauser and Eslora were both lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. They should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
