ARREST RELEASE

ROCKFORD, Ill. – On Wednesday, June 29, 2016 at approximately 5:28 p.m. Rockford Police officers responded to 3345 Lapey Street 7L for a welfare check. Officers did not get a response at the door and forced entry into the residence to check on 51-year-old Tammy Hudson. Once inside the residence, officers discovered Hudson deceased with at least one stab wound. Her live-in boyfriend, 47-year-old Jason Guski, was also located inside the residence and was unresponsive. Guski was transported to a local hospital where he received medical attention and was released. Guski was interviewed by Rockford Police detectives following his release from the hospital.

Rockford Police detectives continued the investigation overnight and reviewed its findings with the Winnebago County State’s Attorney’s Office who authorized the following charges for:

Jason R. Guski Age 47

Charges: First Degree Murder (two counts)
Concealing a Homicidal Death

At the time of his arrest, he was also wanted on a No Bond Failure to Appear Warrant stemming from a prior Domestic Battery arrest.

Detectives charged Guski and he was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail with No Bond. A photo of Guski is attached.

This is an ongoing investigation and no additional information is available at this time.
