ARREST RELEASE

Rockford, IL – On Wednesday, January 20, 2016 the Rockford Police department was contacted by Orland Park, Illinois police detectives in reference to possible fraudulent activity at a local jewelry store.

Rockford detectives met with the owner of the business based on the information received. Detectives from the department established surveillance inside and outside of the store. The subject in question arrived on scene, entered the store, and attempted to make a purchase. The purchase was ultimately declined and the subject was taken into custody outside of the business as he attempted to leave the premises.

The arrested subject, Carl A. Mack, black male, 30 years of age, was charged with Obstructing Justice, No Valid Driver's License and an outstanding warrant from the Department of Corrections. Additional charges pending in reference to the fraudulent activity.

Rockford Police would like to thank the Orland Park Police Department for information sharing which allowed the department to proactively address criminal activity in Rockford.

The charges against Mack are merely accusations. He is presumed innocent unless proven guilty in a court of law.
