### **ARREST RELEASE**

On June 30, 2016 at around 1:30 a.m., Rockford Police SCOPE officers stopped a speeding silver Dodge Charger in the 400 block of Underwood Avenue. After approaching the driver, the officers suspected he was driving under the influence of alcohol and asked him to step from the vehicle. During a pat down, officers discovered an amount of suspected cannabis and during further search, they also recovered suspected heroin packaged for delivery.

After further investigation, the driver, Jonathan Hughes, a 36 Rockford man, was arrested for Speeding, Failure to Signal, Driving While License Revoked, Possession of Heroin with Intent to Deliver Within 1000 feet of Rockford housing Authority Property, and Aggravated Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

Hughes was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. Hughes should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
