ARREST RELEASE

On Friday August 15, 2014 at about 11:30 a.m., Ezekial Deanda, a 32-year-old Rockford man, entered the Associated Bank located at 612 N. Main Street. While completely disrobed, Deanda approached a personal banker, announced a robbery, and demanded money. Deanda fled from the lobby area with an undisclosed amount of United States Currency; however, he was located by responding Rockford Police Officers in the basement restroom of the bank while getting dressed. Deanda briefly struggled with Officers and spit upon before they took him into custody.

Ezekial Deanda was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail on the following charges:

Robbery

Resisting a Police Officer

Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer

Deanda should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
