Incident: **Burglary Arrest Clears Several Cases**

MESSAGE

For the last several months the Rockford Police Department has been investigating several property crimes in the neighborhoods around the Rockford Plaza, 2500 Charles Street. These incidents were residential burglaries, burglary to motor vehicles, deceptive practices and finally a home invasion in the 200 block of South Vale Avenue.

In early November a suspect was developed and on 11/12/2013 Rockford Police Patrol Officers located this suspect hiding in a closet in an apartment in the 2300 block of 8th Avenue. This suspect was interviewed by Detectives and subsequently charged.

Charged:

Lorne R. Scott, white male, 05/12/1963, Rockford Resident.

Charges:

- 2 Counts of Residential Burglary stemming from two incidents at a residence in the 200 block of S. Vale Av
- 2 Counts of Burglary to Motor Vehicle stemming from incidents in the 2600 block of Charles Street and 600 S. Rockford Avenue.

At the time of his arrest Scott was wanted on a Rockford failure to appear warrant for fraud and a Lee County failure to appear warrant for forgery.

Scott's arrest clears a total of eight cases. Scott is on probation for misuse of credit card. A photo of Scott is attached to this release.

The charges against Scott are accusations. He is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
