Incident: **Arrest warrant for Residential Burglary suspect**

MESSAGE

On Tuesday, August 13th, 2013 members of the Rockford Police Department responded to 804 Soper Avenue in regards to a Residence Burglary. Officers investigating the incident learned the suspects gained entry into the residence by forcing a walk through garage door, then entered the residence by forcing the door leading from the garage into the house. Once inside the suspect(s) took electronic equipment.

Rockford Police Detectives conducted follow up investigation into the incident. The facts of the investigation were reviewed by the Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office. The following charges were authorized:

**Antrone Cook, 18 years of age, Rockford, Illinois
Residential Burglary.**

Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Cook.

The charge against Cook is merely an accusation. He is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

A photograph of Cook is not being released at this time due to the ongoing investigation.
