Incident: **Fatal Pedestrian Hit and Run Accident**

MESSAGE

On Saturday December 28, 2013 around 5:45pm, members from the Rockford Police and Fire Departments were sent to the 1900 block of Charles St in reference to a pedestrian who had been struck by a vehicle. Upon their arrival, they located 27yo Michael Livingston of Rockford on the north side of the roadway. Livingston was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Initial investigation revealed Livingston and a friend were walking westbound on Charles St in the roadway. Livingston was struck by the suspect vehicle which was also traveling west. The driver of the suspect vehicle fled the scene and was last seen traveling west on Charles St. The suspect vehicle may have been a dark colored 4 door vehicle.

The Rockford Police Department Traffic Investigations Unit is currently conducting the investigation of this hit and run accident.
