Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded to a structure fire in the 2000 block of Charles St. When the first units arrived on scene we were informed by a citizen there was a different house on fire 4 blocks west. A Rockford District Chief responded from 2000 Charles St. to investigate and found a vacant house at 1610 Charles St with fire coming from the front of the house. This 2 family house was a vacated building with no occupants inside. Rockford 911 dispatched fire units to respond to 1610 Charles St. Rockford Fire crews were able to make a quick attack on the fire and get it under control. A Rockford fire investigator responded to investigate the fire. Charles St was closed down for the duration of fire fighting operations and has been reopened.
