## Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded to a reported house fire at the above address. First arriving fire crews found the story and a half house full of smoke with two adult residents standing outside. The fire was discovered in a basement bedroom and was extinguished within eleven minutes of the arrival of the Fire Department. Damage from the fire was limited to the basement of the house, but smoke damage extended throughout.

The cause of the fire has not yet been determined after an investigation. Damage was estimated at \$15,000 to the house and an additional \$5,000 to contents.

Red Cross assisted with housing for the two adult and four children who lived in the home.

Fire crews remained on scene for two hours completing overhaul and clean-up.
