Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded to a possible structure fire. The first unit arrived on scene within two minutes and twenty seconds to find a 2-story, multi-family building with fire coming from the front porch and extension into the first and second floors of the apartment. Fire crews determined that all occupants were out of the building, and the extinguished the fire without incident. The Red Cross responded as the fire displaced seven people (five adults and two children). Damages are estimated to be approximately \$20,000, and the cause is still under investigation.
