Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded to a reported house fire at the above address. First arriving fire crews found smoke showing from the second floor of the two story home. Fire personnel made an interior attack and found the fire in the kitchen area on the ground floor of the building. The fire had extended into the second floor of the house through an interior wall and had burned through the floor into the basement. Several hose lines were advanced to all floors of the house and the fire was brought under control in all areas within twenty-two minutes. The building was unoccupied at the time of the fire. The home's owner arrived and was interviewed by a fire investigator. The cause of the fire was determined to be accidental due to a candle. There were no injuries to either civilians or fire personnel. Damage was estimated at \$40,000 to the house and an additional \$5,000 to contents.
