Narrative:

The Rockford Fire Department was dispatched to the address listed above for a reported house fire. First arriving fire crews found smoke coming from the basement of the one story house and the occupants standing outside. The occupants stated there was no one inside of the home.

Fire personnel entered the house through a rear doorway, entered the basement and extinguished the fire. Additional fire crews searched the entire building and confirmed there were no victims inside. The fire damage was limited to a basement laundry area with smoke damage throughout the home. The fire was brought under control within twelve minutes of the arrival of fire crews.

Damage was estimated to be \$30,000 to the building and an additional \$10,000 to contents. There were no injuries to either home occupants or fire department personnel.

The cause of the fire is still under investigation.
