### *ARREST RELEASE*

On Friday August 14, 2015, District 2 Rockford patrol officers were dispatched to the 2800 block of 10<sup>th</sup> Street to investigate a suspicious person's complaint. Upon arrival, 18 year old Kyle Holliday fled from responding officers. Officer's pursued Holliday ultimately catching him in the 2900 block of Lapey Street. When Holliday was taken into custody, arresting officers located a loaded 9mm handgun between his feet. The serial number of the firearm had been removed. Holliday did not possess a concealed carry permit, nor did he possess a valid Illinois Firearm Owners Identification Card.

Arrested: Kyle Holliday, 18 years old, Rockford

Charges: Aggravated Unlawful Use of Weapons, No Firearm Owners Identification Card, Criminal Defacement of a Firearm, and resisting arrest.

Kyle Holliday is presumed innocent unless convicted in a court of law.
