### ARREST RELEASE

ROCKFORD, ILL. – On Friday May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at approximately 3:30 a.m. Rockford Police Officers responded to the 700 block of Furman St. in reference to shots fired. When they arrived officers located the 24 year old victim, Tevin Miller, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the chest and abdomen. Miller was transported to a local hospital where he was treated for his injuries.

Rockford Police Detectives conducted a follow-up investigation and the results were reviewed by the Winnebago County State’s Attorney’s Office. As a result a warrant was issued for the suspect, Mason Warren, for Attempted Murder and Aggravated Battery with a Firearm with a bond of \$1,000,000. Warren was also wanted on an unrelated warrant for Armed Robbery with a \$200,000 bond.

On Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 the Rockford Area Crime Stoppers office received information regarding Warren’s whereabouts. That information was shared with detectives from the Rockford Police Dept. who in turn contacted the Memphis, TN Police Dept. Officers from Memphis Police Dept. were able to locate Warren and take him into custody. Warren is being held in Tennessee pending extradition.
