MESSAGE

On Saturday July 26th at around 9:29 pm, officers of the Rockford Police Department responded to a residence in the 600 block of 12th St. in reference to the report of a home invasion involving a stabbing.

At the residence police located a 16 year old Rockford resident with a head injury.

The investigation determined four (4) subjects planned and attempted to rob the 16 year old resident and during the attempt the 16 year old victim stabbed one of the robbers.

Corian Moss (24 year old Rockford resident) unlawfully entered the residence to rob the 16 year old victim and struck him in the head with a pistol causing a laceration to his head. During the attack the 16 year old victim stabbed Corian Moss multiple times with a pocket knife.

Corian Moss ran from the residence with his wife, Victoria Moss (23 year old Rockford resident), who had been with him and part of the robbery attempt. They ran to a vehicle parked nearby and occupied by Brayden Sheley (19 year old Rockford resident) and Alexis Yager (18 year old Rockford resident) who police also determined had been involved in the robbery attempt.

Police located all four suspects at an area hospital where Corian had been taken for treatment of his stab wounds.

All four suspects were charged with home invasion and aggravated battery.

- Corian Moss - 24 years of age- Rockford resident
- Victoria Moss - 23 years of age - Rockford resident
- Brayden Sheley - 19 years of age - Rockford resident
- Alexis Yager - 18 years of age - Rockford resident
