Incident: **Joint Burglary Investigation**

MESSAGE

On Monday April 7th, 2014 Rockford Police Detectives, Rockford NRU Officers, Winnebago County Sheriff's Detectives and Loves Park Police Detectives were working on a joint Burglary investigation. During that investigation several Officers and Detectives approached two men outside of 1125 19th Street. While conducting their investigation a third man ran from 1125 19th Street and fled from officers on foot. A foot pursuit was initiated and the suspect was caught several blocks away. During the investigation Officers recovered several firearms and numerous pieces of stolen property. The suspect who fled was charged as follows:

Arrested: William R. Hall Age 28 Rockford

Charges: Unlawful Use of Weapon by a Felon
 Possession of a Stolen Firearm
 Possession of Stolen Property
 Resisting Arrest

The joint investigation will continue and additional arrests are possible.

No photos are available at this time due to the ongoing nature of the investigation.

The defendant is presumed innocent unless proven guilty in court.
