### INFORMATION RELEASE

**ROCKFORD, ILL.** – On Sunday, 07/31/16, shortly before 1:30 a.m. patrol officers from the Rockford Police Dept. responded to a residence in the 3200 block of Greendale Dr. in reference to a call for shots fired. When they arrived officers located a shooting victim, a 15 year old male, who was suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced dead. The name of the victim is not being released at this time pending notification of his family.

A short time later, two additional shooting victims arrived a local hospital for treatment. Those victims, a 17 year old female and a 13 year old female, had also received their injuries during the incident on Greendale Dr. Both of the female victims were treated and released.

Detectives from the Rockford Police Dept. are conducting a follow-up investigation into the incident. Based on the information available at this time it is believed that a party was taking place at the residence when a dispute took place among several individuals. During the dispute several shots were fired. None of the victims who were injured by the gunfire are believed to have been involved in the dispute.
