INFORMATION RELEASE

ROCKFORD, Ill. – On Sunday, July 31, 2016, shortly before 1:30 a.m., patrol officers from the Rockford Police Department responded to a residence in the 3200 block of Greendale Drive in reference to a call for shots fired. When they arrived officers located a shooting victim, a 15-year-old-male, who was suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced dead. **The victim has been identified as Gregory Hill of Rockford.**

A short time later, two additional shooting victims arrived at a local hospital for treatment. Those victims, a 17-year-old female and a 13-year-old female, had also received their injuries during the incident on Greendale Drive. Both of the female victims were treated and released.

Detectives from the Rockford Police Department are conducting a follow-up investigation into the incident. Based on the information available at this time it is believed that a party was taking place at the residence when a dispute took place among several individuals. During the dispute several shots were fired. None of the victims who were injured by the gunfire are believed to have been involved in the dispute.
