MESSAGE

The Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that an individual was involved with selling drugs at various locations throughout the city of Rockford. Soon after the investigation was initiated the subject was identified as Jerry T. Huey. On 01/29/14, at the completion of the investigation, detectives with the Rockford Narcotics Unit, along with assistance from the Community Services Unit and newly formed Neighborhood Response Unit (NRU) took Huey into custody without incident in the 1000 block of Brooke Rd. Huey was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail and charged with the below listed charges.

Arrested: Huey, Jerry T. 31, Rockford

Charges: Delivery of 1-15 grams of cocaine, Delivery of 1-15 grams of cocaine in a drug free zone, and Delivery of 15-100 grams of cocaine.

Bond: No Bond (Felony charge, must be set by Judge)

Huey is innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
