MESSAGE

The Rockford Police Department's Pilot Police District Neighborhood Response Unit (NRU) received information about a subject who was involved with selling cocaine from a residence in the 400 block of North 2nd St. An investigation was initiated and the suspect was identified as Jhordyn L. Ford. On Saturday 2/22/14 at approximately 11:00 P.M. members of the Rockford Police Department's Neighborhood Response Unit and the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department's Special Focus Unit executed a Search Warrant at 421 N. 2nd Street. Ford was located within the residence. Recovered from within the residence was an amount of Cocaine, Cannabis, a loaded handgun and a large amount of United States Currency.
