ARREST RELEASE

During the morning hours on 02/24/15 members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit along with officers from District 2, executed a search warrant at 806 Sawyer Rd. Inside the residence, narcotics detectives located one adult male, two adult females, a young child, and an infant. Upon searching the residence detectives located and recovered a rifle, two handguns, ammunition, and United States currency. Detectives also recovered 13 individually wrapped bags that each contained a substance believed to be heroin.

The adult male was identified as Darryl L. Lyles. Lyles was taken into custody without incident and charged with the below listed violations. Lyles was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. The other occupants were released and not charged.

Arrested: Lyles, Darryl L. 30, Rockford

Charges: Possession with intent to deliver 1-15 grams of heroin within 1,000 feet of a church, No F.O.I.D., and Unlawful use of a Weapon by a Felon.

Bond: No Bond. Felony charges must be set by Judge.

Lyles is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
