### MESSAGE

Recently the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that a subject who resided at 707 King St. was involved with delivering crack cocaine at various locations within Rockford. An investigation was initiated and the suspect was identified as Jeffrey Whitaker. As a result of the investigation a search warrant was obtained for the upper apartment at 707 King St. Whitaker was located and taken into custody without incident. A search of the apartment yielded a small amount of suspected crack cocaine, United States currency, and other items associated with drug trafficking. Whitaker, who is currently on probation from a prior drug arrest, was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.

**Arrested:** Whitaker, Jeffrey R 23, Rockford

**Charges:** Possession with Intent to deliver less than 1 gram of cocaine within 1,000 feet of a church.

**Bond:** No Bond (Felony charge, must be set by Judge)

Whitaker is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
