MESSAGE

Members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that a subject named Thomas J. Arrington was involved with selling cocaine from his residence located at 3042 Marshall St. Based on the information provided, narcotics detectives initiated an investigation. As a result of the investigation, detectives were able to obtain a search warrant for the residence. Detectives located three adults, including Arrington, and one child inside the residence. A search of the residence yielded over 500 grams of cannabis, over 91 grams of cocaine, United States currency, and other items associated with drug trafficking. Arrington, who is currently on probation, was arrested for the listed charges and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. The other two adults were released without charges

Arrested: Arrington, Thomas J. 57, Rockford

Charges: Possession with Intent to deliver 15-100 grams of cocaine,
Possession with intent to deliver 500-1000 grams of cannabis.

Bond: No Bond (Felony charge, must be set by Judge)

Arrington is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
