### MESSAGE

In a joint investigation, the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit and U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration executed a search warrant at 1312 Harding St. on 06/03/13. There were two adult males and one adult female that were located at the residence. A search of the residence yielded over nine gross grams of a substance that field tested positive for heroin. Other items associated with drug trafficking were also located. One of the males was identified as Julius M. Butler and he lived at the residence. Butler was placed under arrest and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. The other two individuals were released and not charged. Butler is currently on parole for a previous class X felony drug conviction.

According to the Winnebago County Assessor's office, the owner of 1312 Harding St. is William Butler.

Arrested: Butler, Julius M. 60, Rockford  
Charges: Possession with Intent to deliver 1-15 grams of heroin within 1,000 feet of a school.

No Bond (Felony X charge, must be set by Judge)

Butler is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
