### MESSAGE

The Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that a subject named Mack Jones was selling crack cocaine. Jones would do so by delivering the crack cocaine to his customers at different locations within the city of Rockford. Jones is currently on parole from a previous felony drug conviction. After several weeks the investigation concluded and Jones was taken into custody on 10/15/13 around the area of 11<sup>th</sup> St. and 18<sup>th</sup> Ave. for two counts of delivery of 1-15 grams of a controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a park. At the time of Jones' arrest he was in possession of an additional 21 bags of crack cocaine. Jones was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.

Arrested: Jones, Mack 46, Rockford

Charges: Delivery of 1-15 grams of a controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a park (2 counts), Possession with Intent to deliver 1-15 grams of a controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a park.

Bond: No Bond (Felony charge, must be set by Judge)

Jones is innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
