ARREST RELEASE

Recently detectives with the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that crack cocaine was being sold from 2940 8th St. As a result of an investigation, a search warrant was obtained and executed on 10/27/15. An adult male and an adult female were located inside the residence. A search of the residence yielded several individual bags of suspected cocaine which were packaged for sale. Other items indicative of drug sales were also located.

The male was identified as Anthony Simmons. Simmons was charged with possession with intent to deliver 1-15 grams of cocaine. The female was identified as Shaylyn A. Goldthwaite. Goldthwaite was taken into custody after it was learned she was wanted on a Boone County warrant. Both Simmons and Goldthwaite were transported to the Winnebago County Jail and lodged.

Arrested: Simmons, Anthony 22, Rockford, IL
Charge: Possession with Intent to deliver 1-15 grams of cocaine.
Bond: \$25,000

Arrested: Goldthwaite, Shaylyn 18, Rockford, IL
Charge: Boone County warrant

Simmons and Goldthwaite are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
