ARREST RELEASE

Within the past few weeks, members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that a male subject was selling cocaine from his residence at 646 15th St. Rockford Narcotics detectives initiated an investigation and identified the suspect as Leobardo De Santiago. As a result of the investigation, the detectives were able to obtain a search warrant and executed it during the afternoon hours on 3/18/15. During a search of the residence over 31 gross grams of suspected cocaine was recovered. Other items associated with drug trafficking, including United States currency, was located and recovered. De Santiago was located at the residence along with others that included two young children. De Santiago was taken into custody without incident. De Santiago was also wanted on an outstanding warrant.

Arrested: De Santiago, Leobardo 34, Rockford

Charges: Possession with intent to deliver 15-100 grams of cocaine.

Bond: No Bond. Felony charge must be set by Judge.

De Santiago is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
