ARREST RELEASE

Members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information that a subject was selling cocaine from his residence at 515 Michigan Ave. An investigation was initiated and as a result a search warrant was obtained for the residence. On 5/28/15 the Narcotics Unit executed the search warrant. Inside the residence the detectives located an adult male, adult female, and a five year old child. A search of the residence yielded suspected cocaine, U.S. currency, and other items associated with drug trafficking. The male was identified as Terrance M. Walton and he was taken into custody without incident. Walton, who is currently on parole, was arrested and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. The female and child were released at the scene.

ARRESTED: Walton, Terrance M. 26, Rockford

CHARGES: Possession with intent to deliver less than 1 gram of cocaine within 1,000 feet of a church.

BOND: No bond, felony charge must be set by Judge.

515 Michigan Avenue is entered into the Landlord Registry. The owners of the property are Gerald and Judith Anderson.
