ARREST RELEASE

The Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit became aware of an individual involved with delivering crack cocaine at various locations within Rockford. On 06/03/15 the Narcotics Unit observed the suspect, later identified as Nashawn Nevlis, deliver suspected crack cocaine from a vehicle in the 800 block of Loomis. Rockford Narcotics detectives, DEA Agents, and Rockford patrol officers eventually took Nevlis into custody after a brief foot chase in the area of Auburn St. and Tacoma.

Nevlis was previously convicted of a drug offense for a 2007 case in Winnebago County and sentenced to five years in the Department of Corrections. He was convicted for another drug offense in Boone county for an arrest that took place in 2011 and given a six year sentence. Nevlis is currently on parole for that case.

Nevlis was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.

ARRESTED: Nevlis, Nashawn C.

CHARGES: Delivery of 1-15 grams of a controlled substance within 1,000 feet a church, Resisting a peace officer, and multiple traffic violations.

Bond: No bond, felony charge must be set by Judge.
