ARREST RELEASE

On November 3, 2014, the Rockford Police Department's, District 2 Neighborhood Response Unit executed a narcotics search warrant at 1215 20th Avenue. While searching the residence, officers located Cocaine, a firearm, and items used to package narcotics for sale. Holliman did not possess a valid Illinois Firearms Card. A second female was arrested on an outstanding arrest warrant.

Arrested: Latasha Holliman, 41 years, Rockford

Charges:

- Armed Violence
- Violation Controlled Substances Act – Possession with Intent to Deliver within 1000 feet of a Church
- No FOID
- Unlawful Use of Weapons
- Possession of Drug Equipment

Arrested: Duana Johnson, 25 years old, Rockford

Charge: Outstanding arrest warrant

Holliman is considered innocent unless proven guilty in a court of law.

Winnebago County tax records show the property located at 1215 20th Avenue is owned and maintained by the Rockford Housing Authority, 223 S. Winnebago Street, Rockford, Illinois.
