## MESSAGE

On Friday, 12/13/13 Rockford Police Narcotics Detectives, Officers with the Stateline Area Narcotics Team (SLANT) and Parole Agents with the Illinois Department of Corrections conducted a parolee compliance check on individuals who were on Mandatory Supervised Release for narcotics violations.

The check targeted 29 individuals who lived in the Rockford area. Officer's located 8 parolees, checked 13 other parolee's residences and 8 parolees were not located. While checking a parolee's address at 2804 Searles Avenue, apartment number two, Officers located Deangelo A. Matlouck, male black, 10/17/88. Located in the residence were 77 grams of cannabis and two digital scales, commonly used to weigh and package narcotics for distribution. Matlouck was charged with Violation of the Cannabis Control Act – Possession with Intent to deliver 30-500 grams. Matlouck was lodged in the Winnebago County Justice Center. Matlouck is not on parolee.

The charges against Matlouck are accusations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
