ARREST RELEASE

On March 10, 2015 the Rockford Police Department, Illinois Department of Corrections (IDOC) and the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police conducted a parole compliance check in the Rockford area. Officers checked fifty locations.

The persons checked during this operation were on parole for firearm violations, armed robbery, robbery, narcotic violations, burglary and sex offenses.

Several of the parolees were found to be in violation of IDOC regulations. These violations included testing positive for illegal substance usage and possession of pornography. IDOC also issued three warrants.

Rockford Police arrested and lodged the following parolees for the following offenses:

20 year old **Trayvonte Grant** of Rockford

Armed Violence

Possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance within 1000 feet of a church

Possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance over 15 grams

Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon

Resisting arrest

42 year old **Charles John** of Rockford

Possession of cannabis (30-500 grams) with intent to deliver

The charges against **Grant** and **John** are merely accusations. They are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
