TRAFFIC RELEASE

The Rockford Police Department joint other law enforcement agencies throughout Illinois during the Independence Day Click it or Ticket and Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Campaign. Extra officers were on patrol looking for impaired drivers and those who were not wearing their seatbelts. Both day and night time patrols were conducted between June 22nd and July 5th. These patrols had the following results;

DUI – 1
Seat Belt Violations – 22
Uninsured Vehicles – 9
Speeding Violations – 14
Suspended / Revoked License – 2
Aggravated Fleeing to Elude – 1
Other traffic offenses – 12
Stolen vehicle recovered – 1
Alcohol Offenses -1
Felony Arrests – 4
Warrants Served – 1
