Fall residential street sweeping began on September 26, 2016 and will continue thru completion or until weather conditions dictates that operations be suspended.

During the week of October 3, 2016, street sweepers will be operating in the following areas:

City Limits east to Kilburn Ave – W. State St. north to Auburn
Rock River east to Kishwaukee St. – Lockheed Dr. north to Y Blvd.

Each Thursday throughout the sweeping season, weekly updates will be provided to highlight the areas of the city in which street sweepers will be working. Maps will also be included to provide a visual of areas completed, not completed and those in progress.

All Street Division Operations are dependent on existing weather conditions and are subject to change accordingly. Citizens are urged to approach Public Works Crews with caution and at a reduced speed that is below posted speed limits.

Bridge and Roadway Removal and Repairs – 2016

During the 2016 construction season the City of Rockford will perform the following removals or repairs to these City-owned bridges:

Location #1: North 3rd Street Bridge over the Whitman Street Ramp

- Repairs will be made to the deck joint at the north abutment, structural concrete repair, and painting steel superstructure.

Location #2: North 3rd Street Bridge over the Southbound 6th Street Ramp

- Full removal of this structure, which has been closed since March 2015 due to advanced deterioration. The removal will result in a reconfiguration of the off-ramp in order to completely close off access. **Complete.**

Location #3: 10th Street Bridge over Keith Creek

- Full removal of this structure with associated pavement removal and sidewalk improvements. **Complete.**

Location #4: 12th Street Bridge over Keith Creek

- Full removal of this structure with associated pavement removal and sidewalk improvements. **Complete.**

Work has been completed at Locations 2, 3, and 4. Work continues on Location #1 with a lane closure of the west lane through the work zone. The lane closure is expected to last until September 30, 2016.

Drivers are reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zones. Full completion of the project is anticipated by the end of September 2016.

Harrison Avenue Reconstruction Project
(Harrison Avenue between 9th Street and East of 22nd Street)
(11th Street between Wills Avenue and South of 23rd Avenue)

The intersection of Harrison Avenue and 9th Street is currently closed to all traffic for the installation of new watermain and storm sewer. The work duration is expected to be approximately 3 weeks, weather permitting. A detour route will be in place for the duration of the closure. Please use caution when driving in the area.

The intersection of 11th Street and Harrison Avenue is open to one lane of traffic each way, with the exception of Harrison Avenue which remains closed between 9th Street to 11th Street. A detour route is in place for westbound Harrison Avenue. Please use caution when driving in the area.

On Monday, May 2, 2016 full reconstruction work began on Stage 1 of the Harrison Avenue Project. Stage 1 includes drainage channel reconstruction, box culvert reconstruction, road widening, new pavement, curb and gutter, medians, sidewalk, sanitary sewer construction, storm sewer installation, water main replacement, new street lights, new traffic signals, and pavement markings in the westbound lanes of Harrison Avenue between Cannon Street and Hartman Street. Stage 1 construction is schedule to be completed in November 2016.

During the duration of Stage 1 construction, traffic will be shifted to the eastbound lanes of Harrison Avenue between Hanson Street and 22nd Street, and 20th Street between Harrison Avenue and Center Street will be fully closed to traffic with a detour route in place. Additionally, during Stage 1 no access to Harrison Avenue will be allowed at the following intersections: Cannon Street, Sewell Street, Congress Drive, 17th Street, 18th Street, 19th Street, Hartman Street, and 22nd Street (south leg only).

Drivers are reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zone.

The Harrison Avenue Reconstruction Project consists of a full corridor reconstruction of Harrison Avenue between 9th Street and just east of 22nd Street as well as 11th Street between Wills Avenue and just south of 23rd Avenue, including drainage channel reconstruction, box culvert reconstruction, road widening, new PCC pavement, new HMA pavement, curb and gutter, landscaped medians, multi-use path and sidewalk construction, sanitary sewer construction, water main replacement, storm sewer installation, landscaping, street lighting, new traffic signals, and pavement markings. Full completion of the project is anticipated in late 2017.

City Wide Street Repairs Group No. 5 – 2016
(Concrete)

On Monday, July 18th, 2016 construction work began on the City Wide Street Repairs Group No. 5 (Concrete) project. Full width resurfacing and Road Reconstruction with curb and gutter repairs, sidewalk repairs, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, drainage repairs, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) Hutchins Avenue – South Highland Avenue to Washington Street
- 2) South London Avenue – East State Street to 2nd Avenue
- 3) 10th Street – Brooke Road to Barnum Road
- 4) Custer Avenue – Rockton Avenue to Ridge Avenue
- 5) 10th Street – 5th Avenue to 6th Avenue
- 6) Belmont Boulevard – Riverside Street to Normandy Avenue

Full width resurfacing with structure repairs as need, partial reconstruction of roadway with new curb and gutter and installation of new dry wells to help improve drainage in the area at the following location:

- 1) 8th Street – Roosevelt Road to Sandy Hollow Road

Full width resurfacing with structure repairs as need, partial reconstruction of roadway with new curb and gutter to help improve drainage in the area at the following location:

- 1) Horton Street – Wills Avenue to Reed Avenue

Brick paver repairs, curb and gutter repairs, sidewalk repairs, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, drainage repairs, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

City Wide Street Repairs Group No. 6 – 2016
(Residential)

On Monday, August 20th, 2016 construction work began on the City Wide Street Repairs Group No. 6 – 2016 (Residential) project. Full width resurfacing with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) Bienterra Trail from Puri Parkway to Drainage Ponds
- 2) Brynwood Drive from Mulford Road to Woodmar Road
- 3) Dior Drive from Spring Creek Road to Lambeth Lane
- 4) Lambeth Lane from Shaw Woods Drive to Dior Drive
- 5) Stornway Drive from Brookview Road to Braewild Road
- 6) Sweetbriar Lane from Brookview Road to Jonquil Place
- 7) University Avenue from Rubicon Trail to Northern Avenue
- 8) Hanford Drive from Creekside Lane to Allerton Drive
- 9) Lizum Court from Innsbruck Drive to Cul-de-sac
- 10) Palmetto Road from Thomas Parkway to Sonoma Road
- 11) Palo Verde Drive from Calderwood Drive to Hampton Avenue
- 12) Robinswood Street from White Dove Lane to Cul-de-sac
- 13) Thomas Parkway from Trainer Road to Palmetto Road
- 14) Weaver Road from Trainer Road to Auto Park Drive
- 15) Weymouth Drive from Spring Lake Drive to Raintree Lane
- 16) White Dove Lane from Robinswood Street to Meadow Trace
- 17) 16th Avenue from 21st Street to 22nd Street
- 18) 16th Avenue from 23rd Street to 24th Street
- 19) 29th Street from East State Street to Oak Grove Lane
- 20) 23rd Street from Broadway to 16th Avenue
- 21) Chelsea Avenue from Cardinal Lane to Greenwood Avenue
- 22) Flintridge Drive from Turner Street to Flintridge Court
- 23) Jackson Street from Vale Avenue to Westchester Drive

Bituminous Patching with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) 21st Street Patching at the Intersection of 21st Street and 11th Avenue
- 2) Flintridge Drive Patching from 150 Flintridge Drive to 209 Flintridge Drive
- 3) Medford Drive Patching at the Intersection of Medford Drive and Redbluff Drive
- 4) Oak Knolls Patching from East State Street to Jackson Street

City Wide Street Repairs Group No. 7 – 2016
(Arterial)

On Monday, September 26th, 2016 construction work began on the City Wide Street Repairs Group No. 7 (Arterial) project. Full width resurfacing with curb and gutter repairs, sidewalk repairs, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, pavement striping, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) 6th Street from 1st Avenue to 5th Avenue
- 2) 7th Street from Charles Street to 6th Avenue
- 3) 20th Street from Sandy Hollow Road to Lookout Drive

Reconstruction of roadway with 10” aggregate base and 8” bituminous surface with curb and gutter and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) 7th Street – South Half of Block between Charles Street and 1st Avenue

Full width resurfacing with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) Alta Vista Drive from Bradley Road to Kings Highway
- 2) Parmele Street from 20th Avenue to 21st Avenue
- 3) Ruth Street from Midway Drive to Pierce Avenue
- 4) Dorchester Drive from Homewood Drive to Greenleaf Way

Alleyway Resurfacing with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) 2nd Ward – Alley 638 from the 2500 Block of 2nd Avenue to Alley 639
- 2) 2nd Ward – Alley 639 from the 0200 Block of Rockford Avenue to the 0200 Block of Hollister Avenue
- 3) 2nd Ward – Alley 706 from the 1500 Block of Crosby Street to the 1500 Block of Benton Street
- 4) 3rd Ward – Alley 777 from the 0500 Block of LaFayette Avenue to the 0500 Block of East Jefferson Street
- 5) 3rd Ward – Alley 827 from Alley 838 to Alley 832
- 6) 3rd Ward – Alley 832 from the 1300 Block of Boilvin Avenue to the 1300 Block of Post Avenue
- 7) 5th Ward – Alley 176 from the 1200 Block of Rose Avenue to the 1200 Block of Clover Avenue
- 8) 5th Ward – Alley 188 from the 1200 Block of Loomis Street to Alley 176

Bike Patch construction 2” Hot-Mix Asphalt bike path with 10” aggregate base and shaping and overlaying existing aggregate path with 2: Hot-Mix Asphalt:

- 1) Morgan Street Bridge Bike Path from Existing Bike Path Along Rock River to Concrete Sidewalk along College Avenue.

Reconstruction of the parking lot for Fire Station #6 at 3329 West State Street. The project will include the removal of the existing pavement structure, widening the parking lot footprint for a larger drive aisle, concrete curb and gutter, concrete driveway replacement, concrete sidewalk, inlet adjustments, striping, light pole relocation and fence and gate removal and replacement.

City Wide Sidewalk and ADA Repairs Package #5 2016

City Wide Sidewalk and ADA Repairs 2016 package #5 has begun. Construction activities may include but are not limited to replacing sidewalk and ADA ramps, parkway restoration and other related work throughout the city at various locations on the Northeast and Southeast side of Rockford. The necessary traffic control and signage will be posted.
