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### ***Sandy Hollow Road HSIP Improvements (20<sup>th</sup> Street to Southworth Street)***

Construction activities have just gotten underway along Sandy Hollow Road, from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to Southworth Street. This project is being partly funded by the Federal Highway Administration as part of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) to reduce traffic accidents along this corridor. Sandy Hollow Road will be converted from a four lane roadway in this section to a two lane section with a bi-directional left turn lane. Construction consists of concrete pavement patching, pavement crown correction and resurfacing. Construction is anticipated to be completed in late August.

There will be temporary lane closures and new lane configurations, so motorists should be aware of new traffic patterns during this time. For short periods of time, there will be nighttime work during the resurfacing portion, and Sandy Hollow may be closed to one lane of traffic with flaggers during overnight, off-peak hours for these instances.
