## MESSAGE

On Friday, 06/28/13, at about 6:45 a.m. officers and detectives from the Rockford Police Dept. responded to the intersection of N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. and Y Blvd. in reference to a shooting investigation. Upon arrival officers learned that a 24 year old male victim was travelling alone in a vehicle Southbound on N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. when an occupant of another vehicle fired several rounds in his direction. The victim was struck by at least one round and was transported to a local hospital where he is being treated for non-life threatening gunshot wounds. The name of the victim is not being released at this time.

The suspect vehicle is described as a black or dark colored four door and was last seen travelling Southbound on N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. from the scene. The vehicle was occupied by three to four Hispanic male occupants in their late teens or early 20's.

At this time investigators believe that there may have been several people travelling on N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. at the time of the incident who may have information pertinent to the investigation.
