INFORMATION RELEASE

On Saturday, 04/16/16, at about 1:30 a.m. Patrol Officers from the Rockford Police Dept. responded to the Auburn Manor apartment complex in the 4100 block of Auburn St. in reference to a shooting incident. When they arrived officers learned that two Metro Enforcement security guards had been involved in a physical confrontation with an armed male suspect. During the confrontation one of the Metro Enforcement security guards shot the suspect. The suspect died at the scene as a result of his injuries. The name of the suspect is not being released at this time pending notification of the next of kin.

Detectives from the Rockford Police Dept. are conducting a follow-up investigation into the shooting. Both Metro Enforcement security guards have been released without charge pending the outcome of the investigation and review by the Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office. The names of the security guards are not being released at this time.
