INFORMATION RELEASE

On May 6th, 2016 at approximately 3:30 a.m. Rockford Police Officers responded to the 700 block of Furman for shots fired. Upon arrival they located a 24 year old male who was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. At this time the name of the victim is not being released pending further notification of his family.

Rockford Police Detectives continued the investigation and learned the victim was involved in a verbal argument that escalated into gunfire. Detectives were able to review the investigation with the Winnebago County State Attorney's Office and after that review, a warrant was authorized for the following suspect:

Charge:	Attempt First Degree Murder

	Bond \$1,000,000 or 10% applies	

Warren was also wanted on a prior Armed Robbery Warrant with a bond of \$200,000.

Warren should be considered armed and dangerous and anyone who knows where Warren is located is urged to call 9-1-1 or Crimestoppers.
